Y^{rs} Sir) I understand that there is a Law directing the recording all Negro
and Molattoes that hath been born since the first^{of} November
1780 untill the first Day of March Next I never knew of such
a Law untill I was at Huntington the other Day I have one
Negro Girl named Sidney Aged four years Last November
and the Reverend James Johnston has one other Negro Girl named
Tamar aged eight Last January and William Robinson of
Wayne Township has one Negro Girl aged about three years
aged named Lucy Now Sir We wish you to Register these
Girls according to Law viz. one named Sidney ^{belonging to my self} 4 years of Last Nov^r
one named Tamar aged 8 years Last January belonging to Rev James Johnston
one other named Lucy aged 3 years Last August belonging to William Robinson
Myself and Mr Johnston both live in Amagh Township and whatever
other Matters regarding said Registering that may be wanting I will satisfy
you when I come next to Town and you will Much oblige me
