I William Porter of the Township of Little Britain in the County of
Sancaster Farmer, do hereby enter and return That Benjamin a
Negro Male Child the Son of Negro Jane a Female Slave, was
born in the Month of May in the Year of our Lord One thousand
Seven hundred and Ninety one, and that his said Mother Jane
was duly entered and registered by me at Sancaster as a Slave
pursuant to the Act "for the gradual Abolition of Slavery"
and that the aforesaid Negro Child Benjamin is my Property
and liable to serve until it shall arrive to the Age of Twenty
eight years. Witness my Hand the 15th Day of October,
