enter and return, That ^{the} ~~the~~ ^{child} ~~child~~ ^{Ben}, a Muttato Male
Child, the Son of James a Negro Female Slave
was born on the Twentieth day of January in the
year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred &
Ninety three and that his father ~~James~~ ^{James} was
duly entered and Registered in Chester County as a slave
pursuant to the Act "For the gradual Abolition of
Slavery" and that the aforesaid Negro Child Ben
is my property and liable to law until it shall
come to the age of Twenty eight years. Witness
my Hand and Seal the Fifteenth day of June
in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred
and Ninety three —
