Lanster the 14th October 1780 as a Slave pursuant to
an act for the gradual abolition of Slavery and
that the afore D Negro Child dolet is my property
and capable to serve and capable to serve until
she arrives to the age of twenty eight years
witness my hand this 4th day of March 1789
