made before Mr. Parker Esq. David Pedick
15th May 1793

Samuel Brown farmer of Mendocino township enters of
records a female negro child named Fells, born some time
in February 1793. Oath made according to law.
17th Sept. Coram David Pedick
25th June 1793.

Abrillo Blackmore widow (farmer) of Citrus township en-
ters of records a negro male child named Michael, born
February 25th 1793 Oath made by William Blackmore
son of Abrillo June 29th 1793 Coram
David Pedick

James Ross attorney at law of the town of Washington in the
county of Washington enters of record a female mulatto child
named Emily, born on the 11th of February 1793 the daughter
of a negro slave the property of the said James Ross.
Oath made according to law. Coram
David Pedick
