Henry Woods of Linton township farmer enters of records with the clerk of the peace a female negro child named Larcos born 15<sup>th</sup> day of November 1799. Both made according to law this 23<sup>rd</sup> March 1800 fees 30 cts paid Mr Redick. Coram David Redick copy

Robert Jackson of Pike run township enters with the clerk of the peace a negro male child named Noah born the 24<sup>th</sup> day of April last.
