April 12<sup>th</sup>   
 Charles Davidson dark complexion, about five feet eight or nine inches high, (short build) aged about thirty years by profession a Labourer, has no further family than a wife, name Violet - late from the West Indies (Guyana), resides with some others in Prince Street in the City of, he declares himself a free man.

April 13<sup>th</sup>   
 Holly Winbery Negro aged about fifty years by profession a Labourer, resides in the City bounded with Daniel Thomas, has no family about five feet high black, well made.

April 15<sup>th</sup>   
 Stephen Gilbert Negro aged about 23 years, about five feet high, wife buried, speaks the German Language. Late from Bucks County but no family.

April 18<sup>th</sup>   
 William W. Harris Negro, aged about 25 years about five feet two inches tall, late from Reading has a family three feet tall, got at Lancaster by profession a free man.

 Jeremiah Halligan a dark Mulatto aged between twenty one and twenty two years, late from Little Britain Township, Province of Pennsylvania - is a single man, intends to live with some board at the house of William Prophet Street in north Prince Street in the City of Lancaster.

June 12<sup>th</sup>   
 George Lavan Negro, a single man aged about twenty eight years late from Dumble Township Lancaster County, resides with William Prophet in North Prince Street - has no family by profession a Labourer.

June 12<sup>th</sup>   
 William Prophet Negro, aged about 40 years by occupation a Labourer, has a wife named Lydia, resides in North Prince Street, in Jacob Duvall's House.

June 12<sup>th</sup>   
 James Martin Negro, aged about 14 years by occupation a Hammer Man - has no family, resides with Joseph ... at the far end of North Prince Street, in a House owned by Casper Shaffer.

June 12<sup>th</sup>   
 Alexander Swani, Negro aged about 24 years by occupation a Labourer, late from Shanklin County, Virginia has no family, residing with George W. Allen five feet high with the City in the road leading to the ... called the new bridge, the name Alexander declaring himself a free man.
