NOTE C.—Enumerators will observe that there are 100 questions relating to each farm, which are arranged in four successive divisions of each schedule page.

HOPS, POTATOES (Irish, Sweet), TOBACCO. Table with columns: Area, Crop, and yield for these specific crops.

ORCHARDS-1879, NURSERIES, VINEYARDS, MARKET GARDENS, BEES-1879, FOREST PRODUCTS. Table with columns: Area, Bearing trees, Total value of orchard products, etc.
