Whereas, the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has indicated, pursuant to Act of General Assembly, No. 413, 1945 Session, that it will contribute to the cost of the plans of approved municipal projects within the limits set by such Act, and whereas, the Township of Marple wishes to make application for a grant towards the cost of preparation of the plans for the project listed with estimated construction costs shown; Now, therefore, be it Resolved, that Township of Marple submits this project for consideration by the Pennsylvania Post-War Planning Commission with the request that an allocation be granted by such Commission for 50 per cent of the approved estimated cost of the preparation of the plans of such project, and be it further Resolved, that when and if such Commission approves the project and when and if such Commission makes an allocation toward the cost of the preparation of the plans of such approved project, the Township of Marple will make available a sum equal, at least, to that allocated by the Commission.
