



The Above is the draught of a Survey made November 22^d. 1798 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to W^m. Wolf on the 27th day of Feby. 1786 It contains two hundred Acres and allow. Situate on the Waters of Charleers Creek and is Call'd. Wolf Hollow. In Hoge D.S. N.B. The above mentioned Warrant was Surveyed on the 20th day of Sept. 1786 and returned upon the above described tract of land embracing together with it Jacob Wolfs land. A quarrel afterwards taking place between the brothers, Jacob & W^m. Wolf Jacob entered a caveat against a Patent issuing to William lest he would not convey Jacobs part of the Survey to him - to End all disputes between them, they have now mutually agreed to withdraw the Caveat, and have desired me to Survey W^m. Wolfs land by itself, which I have accordingly done as above. That a Patent may issue to him for his own property alone
