Surveyed the 1<sup>st</sup> day of August 1792 for John Yount the above Described Tract of Land (according to the old marked trees (the same being formerly Surveyed for the s.<sup>d</sup> Philip Breidenbach by Daniel Brodhead Esqr late Deputy Surveyor) Situate on Stoffer's run and Coleman's run which empties into Pine Creek Partly in Berks County and part in Dauphin County, Containing Eighty two Acres and Thirty one perches and the allowance of Sixtent for Roads &c.
