



Situate on the Waters of Sandy Creek in Wharton Township Fayette County, and Surveyed the 9th day of June 1834 In pursuance of a Warrant in the name of David Moreland for 150 acres of land, dated the 29th day of May 1834. There was no improvement on this tract on the day of the Survey, except a loghouse or cabin commenced a few days ago and raised 7 or 8 logs high but nothing more done to it.
