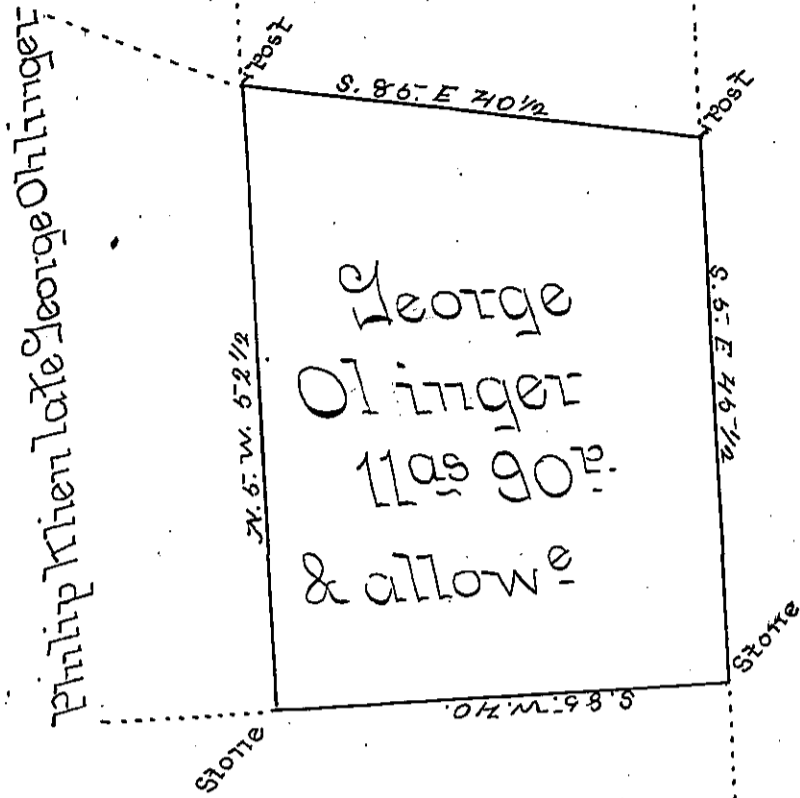

 rge Olinger in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 23<sup>rd</sup>  
 July 1750# Resurvey'd & divided for the Reverend Frede-  
 rick Miller the 23<sup>rd</sup> July 1810.
