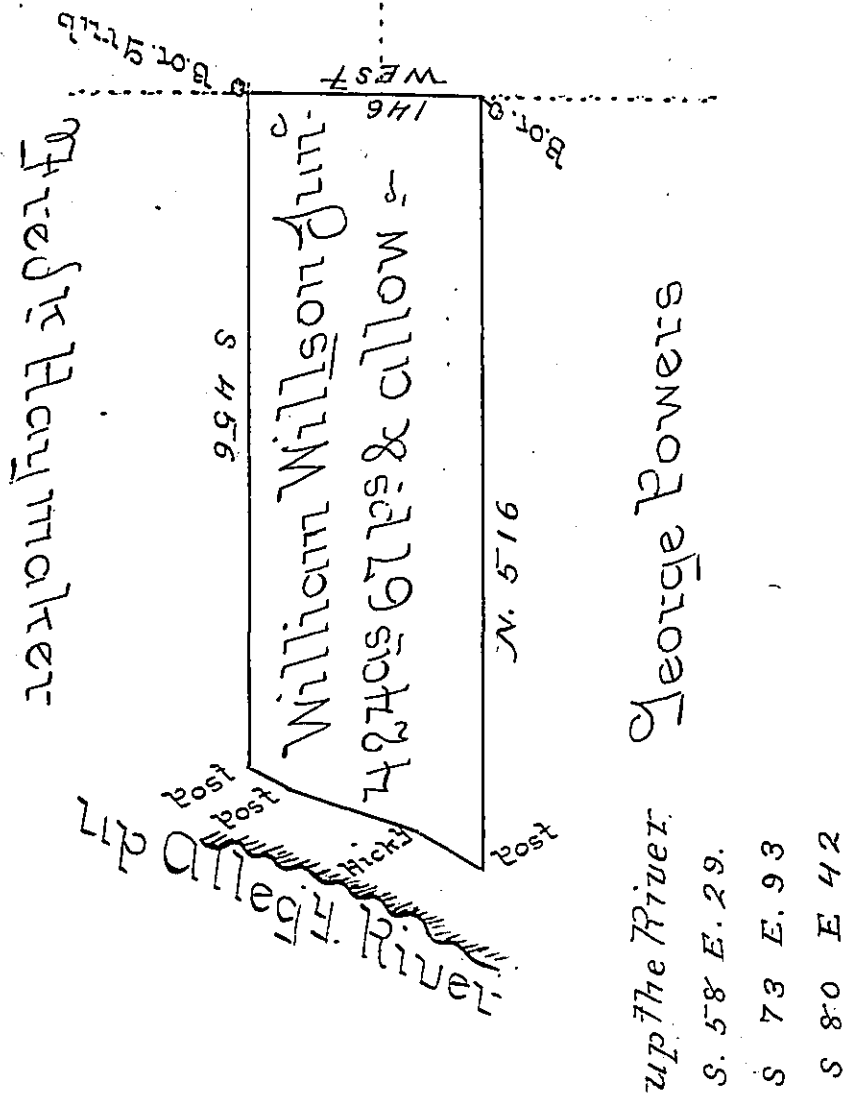


Amos Cross
