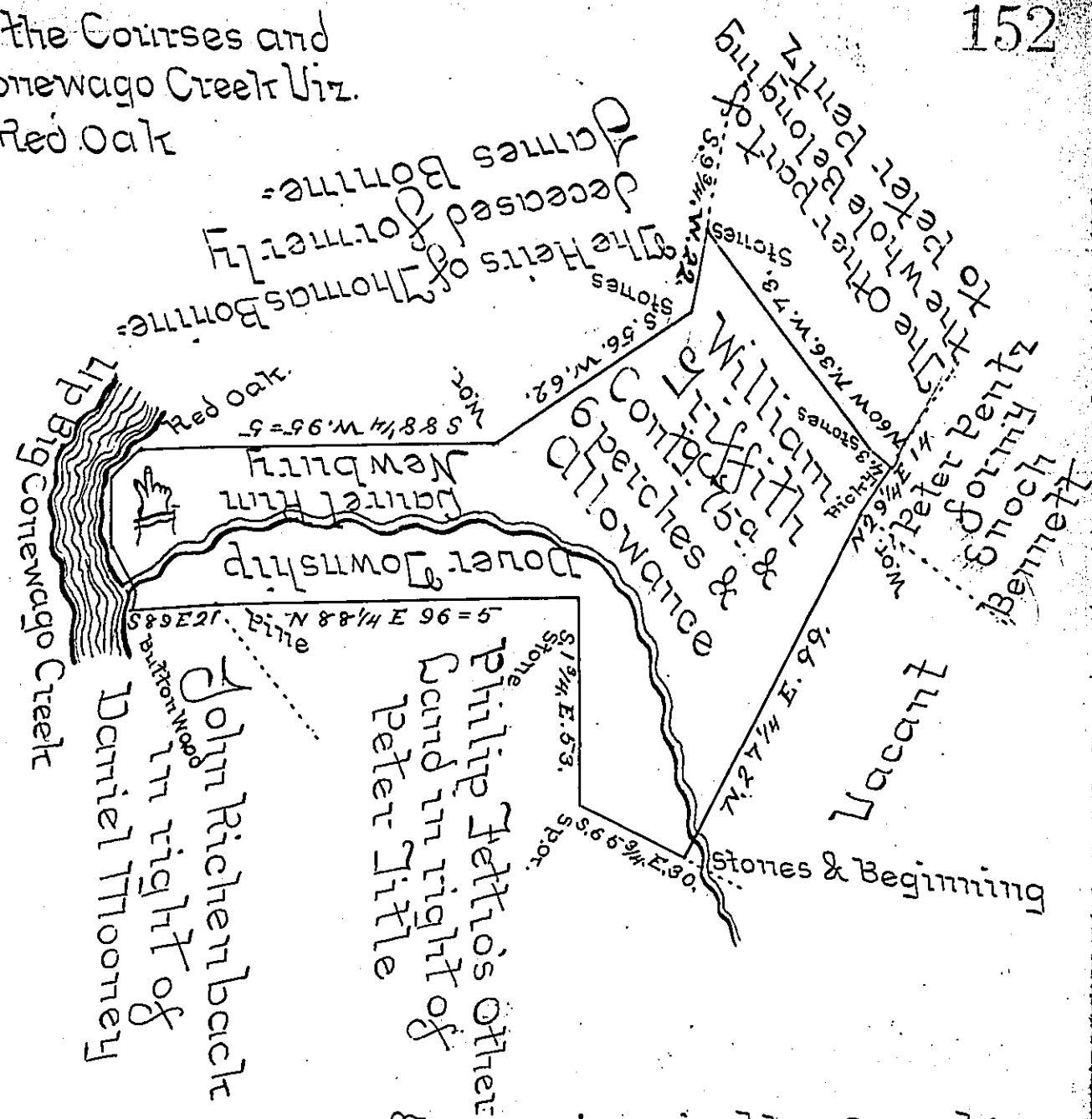


The following are the Courses and distances up Big Cornewago Creek Viz. from Marked Red Oak

Being part of a larger Tract of Land which was originally Surveyed on the 4th day of June Anno Domini 1771. by Charles Lukens late U.S. In pursuance of the Application No 5212 for 100^a granted to William Griffith, bearing date the 15th day of October 1768. Resurveyed & divided off from the said larger Tract of Land the 13th & 15th days of April A.D. 1808. at the instant and Request of Philip Jettro the present owner who desired us to make Return of the Draught.
