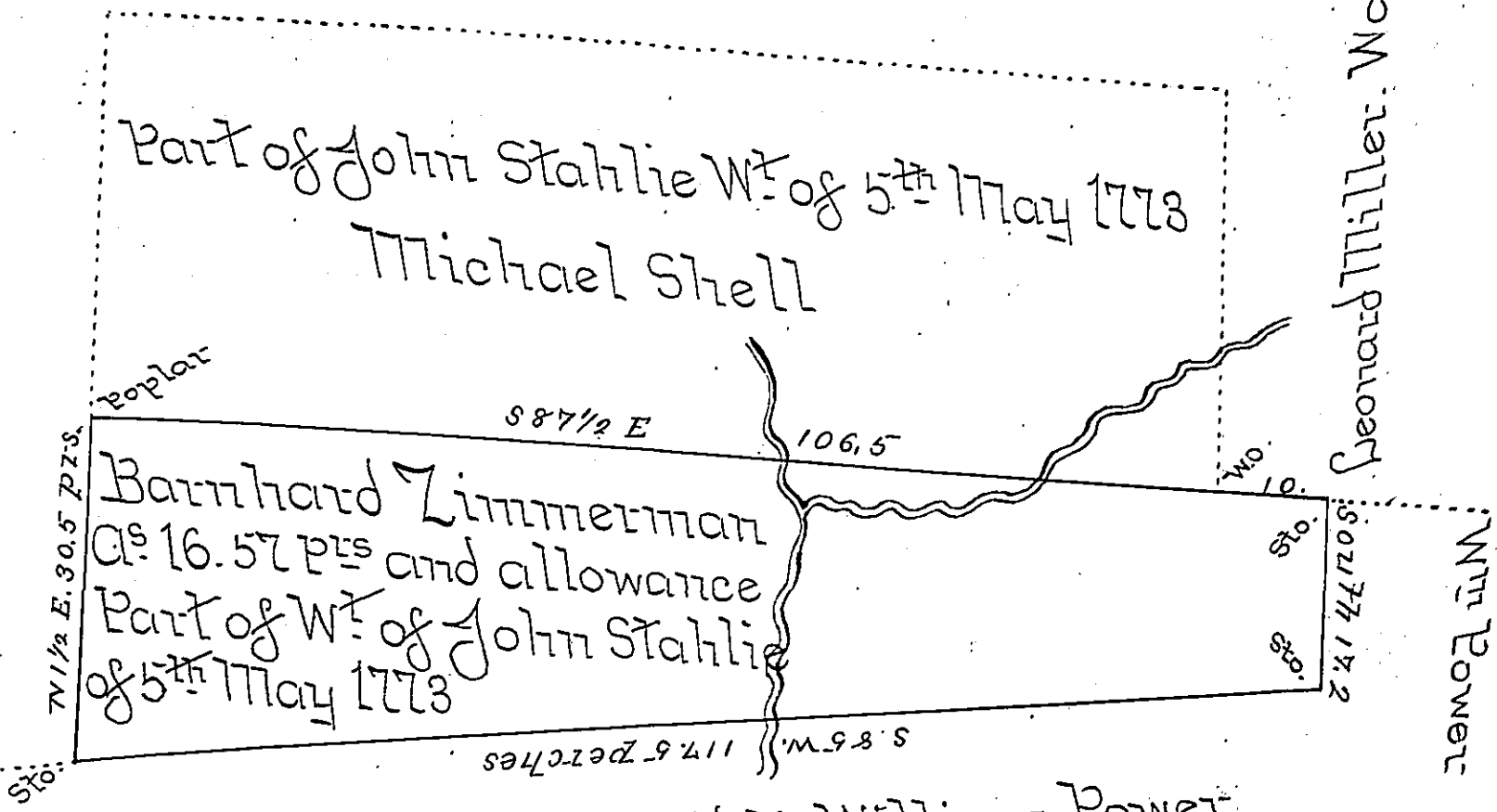


Warrant of Tho. Elder & J.M. Haldeman

Land Warranted to William Power

Resurveyed April 20<sup>th</sup> 1810 for Barnhard Zimmerman the above tract of land, containing six teen acres and fifty seven perches and the usual allowance of six per centum for Roads &c. - Situate now in Williams Township Dauphin County. - It being part of a larger tract of land granted to John Stahlie by Warrant of 5<sup>th</sup> May 1773 then in Lancaster County and surveyed to Baltzer Hamberger on the 24<sup>th</sup> May A.D. 1815. -
