



Situate on the west side of French Creek in Allegheny County containing 401 acres 150 perches and allowance of Six per cent for roads &c. Resurveyed <sup>the 12<sup>th</sup> July 1799</sup> in pursuance of a warrant for 400 acres granted to Robert Ervine bearing date 30<sup>th</sup> May 1792 [It being the same tract of land which was surveyed the 6<sup>th</sup> November 1794 for W<sup>m</sup> Jones on his improvement dated 5<sup>th</sup> Nov. 1794.]
