Meglathery, superintendent; Alexander Newell, collector at the junction office; Joseph Pollock, supervisor; Chas. L. Schlatter, here, although of the Beaver Division, writing in his capacity as a principal engineer a report recommending repairs for the canal; Dr. Chas. T. Whippo, engineer; and Thomas L. Wilson, secretary to the Canal Board.

Uncalendared, the contents of this volume range from 1829 to 1840. They consist chiefly of claims and awards for damage to lands and are indexed in alphabetical order of the names of the claimants.
