Here, irregularly calendared, are contracts to "dig, embank, puddle, and construct, etc." sections of a canal forty feet wide at the top, twenty-eight feet wide at the bottom, and four feet deep on the Tangascootack Extension of the West Branch Division and on the West Branch Division.

Contracts for the Tangascootack Extension are signed by Superintendent Alex. B. Reed in 1836 (items 1-10) and by Superintendent Geo. Crawford in 1835 (items 11-17).

Contracts for the West Branch are signed by Superintendent Andrew McReynolds in 1828 (items 18-72), by Wm. F. Packer in 1832 (items 73-86), and by Superintendent Wm. B. Mitchell in 1831 (items 87-90).

Contracts in 1828 were based upon plans exhibited by Engineer F. W. Rawle.
