

W2-i. 22. NORTH BRANCH DIVISION - Contracts:
Sections, Vol. 2

Here the title is too general: all items included apply strictly to the Tioga Line of the North Branch Extension Canal. Moreover, the contracts, all of them on printed forms, require not only the construction of the standard canal 40' by 28' by 4', but also of such features as locks, etc.

The contracts are signed in 1836 - 1837 by Superintendents Jere Adams and William Keeler, the vast majority by the latter, and, in 1840, by Superintendent Victor E. Piollet.
