W2-i. 34. NORTH BRANCH DIVISION - Releases and Damage Compensation

Here, indexed from Attwater, Eunice through Youse, Geo., uncalendared, but running 1829 - 1840, are releases and other forms of receipt for injuries done to lands and properties or for services not previously compensated for. Printed forms occur, but, chiefly, documents are in long hand.

Certifying to claims from time to time are canal officials such as Acting Commissioner John Mitchell and Superintendents Lord Butler, Wm. Keller, E. Harding, Jr., and others.
