

file connected with the Allegheny Feeder, superintended in construction by Sherman Bills, for the purpose of feeding the Western Division Canal above Freeport on the Allegheny River; and one connected with the Western Reservoir, superintended in construction by Robert Faries and Timothy Ives, to feed the Western Division below Johnstown.

Further, it may be noted that two files record work done in the extension of the West Branch Division above the mouth of Bald Eagle Creek at modern Lock Haven: one, the Tangascootack Extension, superintended by Alexander B. Reed, which was completed along the West Branch of the Susquehanna to Farrandsville; the other, the Sinnemahoning Extension, superintended by George Bressler and never completed. These files are included among the West Branch Division files.
