

W2-f. 8. ALLEGHENY PORTAGE RAILROAD - Damage Claims

Here, indexed from Anthony, Chas. D. through D. Leech & Co. and for White, Geo. R. & Co., but uncalendared and running through scattered years, 1840 - 1856, are claims for services in arrears, for damages to property, etc.

Interesting among claims of transportation companies are items 117-121, recording the claim of John Dougherty of Blair County for his charges for hauling passengers - 1858.

W2-f. 9. ALLEGHENY PORTAGE RAILROAD - Contractors for Relief

Here, indexed from Adams, J. through Karney, Jno. D. and for Wood, Morrill & Co. and White & Co., but uncalendared and running through years, 1839 - 1859, are contractors making appeal for relief for various causes.

W2-f. 10. ALLEGHENY PORTAGE RAILROAD - Contractors for Relief

Here, indexed from Appleton, James & E. through Young, Edward A. G., but uncalendared and running through years, 1831 - 1857, are contractors and engineers making appeal for relief for various causes.

Among engineer claimants are Robert Faries, A. B. Warford, and Sylvester Welch.

Most interesting among contractor claimants are Snodgrass and Durno (items 93-101), builders of the viaduct across the Conemaugh near the "Horse Shoe" bend - 1834. In items 96-97 appears a pencil drawing of the viaduct and its setting among the mountains.
