

K NOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I *Samuel Martin* a Soldier in the late *Third* Pennsylvania Regiment, in the service of the United States, do constitute and appoint *John Farise of Montgomery County Maryland* my lawful and true Attorney, with full Power and Authority to appear at the proper Office or Offices and receive in his own name and for his own benefit and use, all such Pay, Arrears of Pay, Rations, Cloathing, Lands, or Depreciation of Pay, that may be due me from the United States or any particular state, for my services rendered as aforesaid, hereby ratifying all that my Attorney or his substitute or substitutes shall do therein by virtue hereof.
