 by Col. Proctor in the Military for and in con-
 sideration of the sum of Twenty Pounds to me in hand
 paid at the execution hereof by William Repton the
 receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge; Have granted
 bargained and sold, assigned and set over, and by
 these presents Do grant bargain and sell, assign and
 set-over, unto the said William Repton his heirs and
 assigns forever, all the estate, right, title, interest of, in,
 and to certain Military Lands Warrants, granted, or to be
 granted, for surveying to me One hundred acres of Land
 from the United States, and also Ten hundred acres, from
 the state of Pennsylvania be the same more or less, in any
 of the districts, appropriated to satisfy the bounties of Lands,
 due to the late army of the United States, and the State of
 Pennsylvania and all the Lands surveyed in pursuance
 thereof unto the said William Repton his heirs & assigns,
 and their proper use and behoof forever. And I do hereby
 authorize and empower the said William Repton his heirs and
 assigns, to select and take in his or their names, and to bring
 or their proper use and behoof, the patent to be obtained on the said
 warrants or Lands, returned to the board of Treasury or elsewhere,
 and for a further consideration to me in hand paid, by the
 above named William Repton, I do hereby authorize and
 empower the said William Repton or his heirs or assigns, to
 demand or receive all my pay or arrearages of Pay due to me as a
 Soldier assigned from the United States or State of Pennsylvania
 and to give receipt or receipts, for the same, and to do all
 lawful acts and things, necessary for effecting the same.
