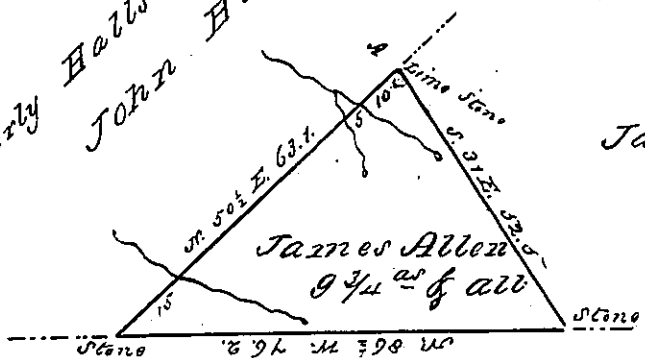


Formerly Halls land now owned by
