Surveyed the 10<sup>th</sup> day of May 1797 for Martin Heshlinger the above described part of land, containing Eighty six Acres, thirty four perches and the usual allowance for Roads. In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 12<sup>th</sup> day of January 1791.
