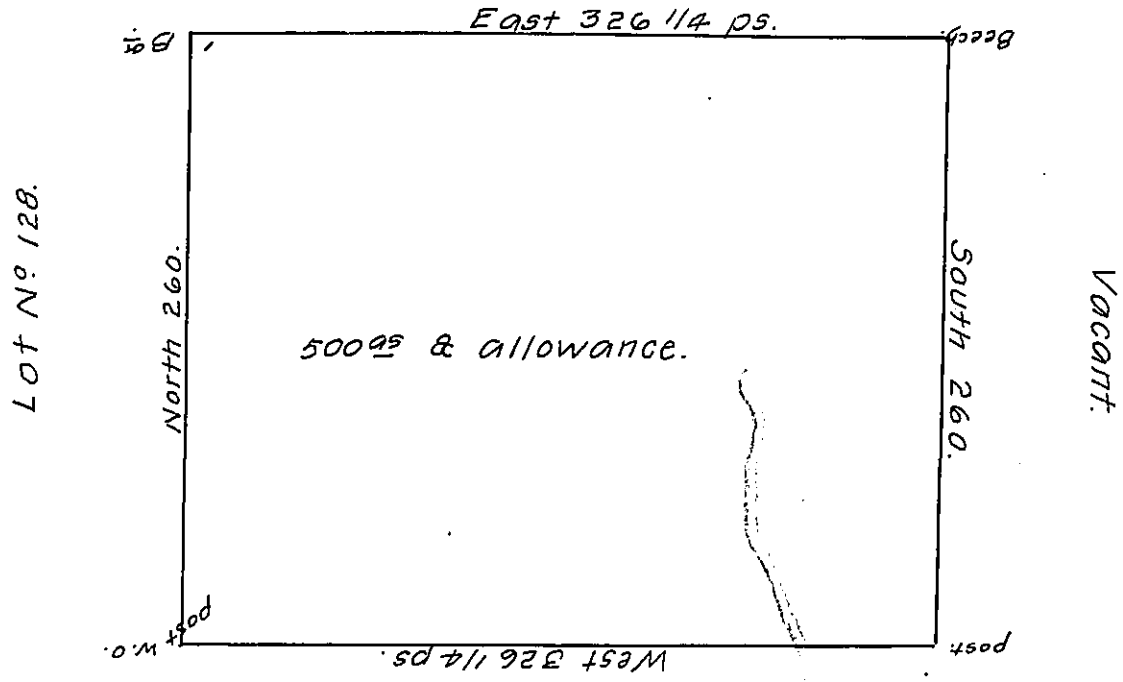

In pursuance of an Act of General Assembly of the state of Pennsylvania, passed the 24th day of February 1785 Intituled an Act for directing the mode of distributing the Donation Lands promised to the troops of this Commonwealth & by order of the surveyor General with the Approbation of the Hon^{le} the Executive Council I have surveyed on the 30th day of July 1785 the above Described tract of five Hundred Acres & Allow. of 6 ~~7~~ Cent. for roads &c. No CXXX situate in District No 7 on the west side of the Allegeny river In the County of Westmoreland.
