69- 71. Contracts for waste weirs, signed with Superintendent Samuel Power in 1834

72- 73. Contracts for aqueducts, signed with Superintendent John Dickey in 1831

74- 90. Contracts for dams, including the two over the Shenango and the Neshannock at the mouth of the Beaver River, signed with Superintendent Dickey in 1831 - 1833. The Shenango Feeder Dam is contracted for with Superintendent John P. Meglathery in 1836

91-103. Contracts for lock houses, signed with Superintendent John Dickey in April, 1833

104-144. Contracts for fences, signed with Superintendent Dickey in 1833

115-125. Contracts in manuscript form for fences, dates running from 1833 forwards. From time to time, Superintendent Dickey affixes his signature

W2-g. 12. BEAVER DIVISION - Land Damage Claims

Here, according to property-holders' names, from Allen, A. B. through Wilson, Jno., are claims and correspondence connected with injury done to lands by the excavation of the canal, the building of dams, etc. Dates, uncalendared, run chiefly between 1832 and 1843.
