W2-g. 27. ERIE EXTENSION CANAL - Damage Claims, Vol. 1

Here, indexed from Baird, Thomas through Koonce, C., uncalendared, but ranging through years 1840 - 1853, are the claims of property-holders for injuries to their lands.

W2-g. 28. ERIE EXTENSION CANAL - Damage Claims, Vol. 2

Here, indexed from Quimby, C. through Wright, James, uncalendared, but ranging through years 1840 - 1853, are the claims of property-holders for injuries to their lands.

W2-g. 29. ERIE EXTENSION CANAL - Damage Claims, Vol. 1

Here, indexed for Lontzenheiser, D. and then Ramsay, S. G. through Williams, J. & J., uncalendared, but ranging 1838 - 1848, are claims of property-holders for injuries to their land and buildings and claims of contractors and engineers for services still unpaid.

Interesting in item 32 is a letter from Engineer Wm. Milnor Roberts.

W2-g. 30. ERIE EXTENSION CANAL - Damage Claims, Vol. 2

Here, indexed for Cotton, Robt. and then from King & Co. through Power & Riley, uncalendared, but ranging through 1839 - 1848, are claims chiefly of property-holders and contractors.
