

W2-h. 2. FRENCH CREEK DIVISION - Damage Claims, Vol. 2

Here, indexed from Beatty, F. through Strain & Dunlop, uncalendared, but ranging through years 1833 - 1844, are claims of property-holders and contractors.

An interesting claimant is Dr. Daniel Bemus in items 93-137.

An interesting correspondent, although unindexed, is Supervisor John Mitchell (former canal commissioner) who, in item 29 under date of 25 November 1844 presents a striking map of Conneaut Lake with water of the French Creek Feeder emptying into it and its own level-raised waters emptying into the Erie Extension Canal.

W2-h. 3. FRENCH CREEK DIVISION - Damage Claims, Vol. 3

Here, indexed from Davis & Parks through Woodworth, D., are claims of property-holders and contractors; uncalendared, these claims range 1835 - 1843.

Claims are certified or refused certification by officials such as Superintendent Hugh Brawley, Principal Engineer Wm. Milnor Roberts, and Superintendent John Anderson.

W2-h. 4. FRENCH CREEK DIVISION - Damage Contracts:
Bridges, releases, etc.

Here the title is somewhat of a misnomer. Actually, the volume contains in its first ten items Articles of Agreement with Superintendent John Anderson, 1833-34, providing that property-holders remove or rebuild certain structures on their lands.
