

Here, irregularly calendared, but signed on divers dates, 1829 - 1834, by Andrew McReynolds, Wm. B. Mitchell, Wm. F. Packer, and other superintendents, are 173 contracts for various types of bridges: foot, road, towing path, etc.

In item 73 under date of 1 April 1829 and signed by Superintendent McRaynolds, is the contract of Reuben Field, John Nesbit, L. B. Stoughton, and R. Wilcox to build the towing path bridge across the West Branch at Northumberland.

Contracts for other towing path bridges occur as follows: Larry's Creek (item 1); two branches of Loyalsock Creek (items 7 and 8); Lewisburg Cross Cut (item 10); and Lick Run on the Tangascootack Extension (item 18).
