

Here, indexed from Boyd, J. & Others through Young, David, uncalendared, but running 1830 - 1857, are the claims of property-holders for injuries to lands or properties by the construction or the operation of the canal or of contractors for services or materials supplied.

W2-h. 31. WEST BRANCH DIVISION - Damage Claims

The title of this volume is inadequate and inexact: beyond damage claims, it contains contracts for waste weirs, towing path sections, and dams and lock sections.

- 85- 90. Contracts, on printed forms, for waste weirs on the Bald Eagle Side Cut and on the West Branch Division, signed in 1834 by Superintendent Wm. F. Packer.
- 91-118. Contracts for sections of towing path, signed by Superintendent Andrew McReynolds in 1829 and by Superintendent Wm. B. Mitchell in 1831.
- 119-142. Contracts for dams and for repairs to dams. These include not only dams in confluents of the West Branch, but the great feeder dams in the river at Dunnsburg and at Muncy Hill; contracts for them are signed by Superintendents Mitchell and Packer.
- 143-164. Contracts for lock sections, signed in 1831 by Superintendent Mitchell.
- 165-168. Similar contracts for lock sections, signed in 1832 by Superintendent Packer
