

All items bear upon the Wyoming Line.

W2-i. 19. NORTH BRANCH DIVISION - Contracts:  
Bridges, waste weirs, etc.

Here the title is inadequate: the volume contains not only contracts connected with bridges (road and farm, items 1-120) and with waste weirs (items 121-141), but also contracts connected with a second series of bridges on the Wyoming Line (items 142-175) and a series of contracts connected with the important Nanticoke Dam, its chutes and its towing path sections (items 176-194).

The contracts are of early date, 1828 - 1833, except for those bearing on the Nanticoke Dam, which run from 1829 to 1840.

Contracts are signed by Acting Commissioner John Mitchell, Superintendents Thos. Woodside and Lord Butler, and, in instances, by Supervisors John Shriner and D. N. Kownover.

Aqueducts, locks, lock houses, bridges, etc.

Items here apply to the North Branch Extension Canal from Lackawanna Creek upstream to Athens.
