Schlatter's estimates of costs for the proposed-but-never-built Harrisburg and Pittsburg Railroad, 1839-1841; that is, for the several alternative routes explored for such a railway: Northern, Southern, Middle, Conemaugh, and Stone Mountain. Its contents relate themselves to the Maps and Profiles for these routes in Map Books 3, 5, 11, and 21 and to papers of Schlatter in Superintendency File C6, 97.
