Packets of Acting Commissioner Charles Mowry's accounts, with voucher lists and vouchers.

- A. 1. Receipts from engineers for salary and expenses: William Strickland, principal engineer; Sylvester Welch, who early in 1826 located the Eastern Division Canal between the mouth of Stony Creek and the mouth of the Swatara; and others.
- 2. Receipts from contractors for excavations, sections, culverts, locks, aqueducts, the Harrisburg basin, etc.
- 3. Receipts from property-holders for damages, for fences built by themselves, etc.
- B. Records of the services of Strickland's assistants: F. W. Rawle; Sylvester Welch; Chas. L. Schlatter, target bearer; Samuel H. Kneass; Rob't Faries, target bearer; William Roderigue; George Merrick; and others.
- C. Records of expenses for the Canal Office's stationery, fuel, furniture, etc.
- D. Records of accounts for repairs to engineers' instruments, etc.
