Here, the voucher list of Sherman Bills, superintendent of the Allegheny Feeder, shows settlement of 8 January 1839, including the names of Principal Assistant Engineer Rob't S. Rodgers and Sub-assistant J. A. Roebling.

Two vouchers signed by John A. Roebling appear among numerous others. One of these is for \$246 for 123 days' service on the feeder from 1 July to 1 November 1838; the other, signed 1 January 1839 for \$122 for sixty-one days from 31 October to 31 December 1838 (including Christmas Day). Both are signed to Superintendent Bills.

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This file of Supervisor John P. Meglathery contains, among other items, foreman's check rolls; bills of Assistant Engineer Joseph Hoops; and contractors' bills for repairs.

Here, too, in voucher 6899 under date of 5 October 1836, is the receipt of Sub-assistant Engineer John A. Roebling for \$74 for thirty-seven days' work, 20 August to 26 September 1836, at \$2 a day, signed by Roebling, who will later on design the Brooklyn Bridge, constituting the earliest record of his service for the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, to Superintendent Meglathery; it is dated 26 September 1836.
