

This volume not only indexes action of the Board relative to such canal features as lock, aqueduct, towing path bridge, and the like, but also bears explicitly upon all such matters as the appointment or the election of commissioners, the duties of acting commissioners, superintendents, supervisors, toll collectors, engineers, etc., with dates of appointment and assignments to service on the particular divisions: Juniata, Western, Delaware, etc.

Through this Index, in brief, may be traced the career of almost any official on The Pennsylvania Canal.

W2-a. 14. INDEX

This 278-page manuscript index to the CANAL COMMISSIONERS' JOURNAL, of years approximately to 1830, has been arranged "divisionally"; that is, under "Columbia Railroad"; "Eastern Division"; and similar headings.

W2-a. 15. INDEX to the OLD JOURNAL

This 78-page manuscript index to early years of the CANAL COMMISSIONERS' JOURNAL covers approximately 1830 to 1835, or pages 1 to 1850.

W2-a. 16 and 17. Two copies of the Index to the arrangement of the CANAL COMMISSIONERS' RECORD BOOKS and MAP BOOKS which was abandoned in the autumn of 1956.

W2-a. 18. An unidentifiable index of men's names: Anderson to Yocumb.

W2-a. 19. REPORT and MAP, 1819, of obstructions in the Ohio River from Pittsburgh to Louisville, Kentucky, by commissioners from Ohio, Virginia, Pennsylvania, and Kentucky, the Pennsylvania Commissioner being Walter Lowrie; 3/4" by 6-1/4" by 8-1/2"; colored maps for all points of obstruction; 100 pp. plus, all in excellent condition.
