

Principal Engineer Chas. T. Whippo, who has employed "Mr. Roebling," certifies to the correctness of the sub-assistant's account, which was notarized by Joseph Emery.

Also, in voucher 7662, 15 May 1837, there is a second receipt of the sub-assistant, signed by Roebling on 21 October 1836 for \$44 for twenty-two days' work between 27 September and 21 October 1836, in a month when his fellows were Sub-assistants Edward Thierry and A. D. Green.

This is a file of George Bressler, superintendent of the Sinnemahoning Extension (never completed). In Bressler's voucher list for 27 November 1838 is mentioned "S." A. Roebling of the engineer corps; here, as Voucher No. 18, is the receipt dated 30 June of J. A. Roebling for "Fourty" Dollars for twenty days' work from the eleventh of June to the thirtieth of June 1838.

Roebling signs his "J" with such a flourish that the superintendent mistakes it for an "S." In his own hand, Roebling calls himself "Sub-assistant on the Sinnemahoning."
