Dr. 75 -10 The contents of this book, numbering 70-odd, consist chiefly of deeds from property-holders and administrators to the Commonwealth or to its Board of Canal Commissioners for tracts or lock house lots along the several divisions of the Pennsylvania Canal. A smaller number consist of deeds from persons to other persons and a few consist of releases and of articles of agreement; they have been newly indexed in the alphabetical order of grantors' names.

For surveys of lock house lots - see W2-a. 26.

Two outstanding items in this book are:

1. Brief of title to two certain lots in the Spring Garden District of Philadelphia County on Schuylkill - Sixth Street at Parke and Hamilton Streets which were earlier part of the Bush-Hill Estate patented to Andrew Hamilton on 24 January 1734 and remained long in the possession of his heirs.
2. Copy of commission by Governor J. Andrew Schulze, 21 April 1825, to Messrs. Robert M. Patterson, John Sergeant, William Darlington, Alnert Gallatin, and David Scott to be the five canal commissioners called for by the Act of 11 April 1825 who are to plan for the building of a Pennsylvania canal system to connect the eastern and western waters.
