Appended to the ten maps is the report to the canal commissioners of Engineer Warford. The maps show locks, the towns of Northumberland and of Sunbury, Shamokin Dam, etc.

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This book, improperly titled "Surveys and Maps: Delaware Division, Juniata and Western Division. Gettysburg Extension," contains no specifically named parts of the Delaware Division.

Among its contents are:

- a. A file of owners of land on Sections 57 - 116 who have land damage claims. Names among them, Reigle, Raub, etc. suggest the Delaware Division
- b. A report - 1841 - to the Canal Board (E. B. Hubley, chairman) on water powers on the Juniata Division, with accompanying surveys of dams and locks
- c. A report, Wm. E. Morris, engineer, on water powers on the Western Division, with accompanying surveys of dams and locks.
