J. Delaware and Schuylkill Canal Navigation Records  
Deposited in the BUREAU of LAND RECORDS of the Department of Internal Affairs

The Delaware and Schuylkill Canal Navigation was a waterway project in the early 1790's (incorporated 10 April 1792, chartered 30 May 1792, with Robert Morris and John Nicholson numbered among its projectors), which was never completed. In later years, such purposes as its projectors had along the Schuylkill were fulfilled by the Schuylkill Navigation Company Canal; such purposes as were intended by the Schuylkill and Susquehanna Navigation Company Canal, also projected and partly built in the 1790's, were subsequently fulfilled by the Union Canal between Reading on the Schuylkill and Middletown on the Susquehanna.
