A detailed report on the condition of the canal works of the several divisions of the Pennsylvania Canal which the Pennsylvania Railroad is, at the time, contemplating purchasing from the state.

A report on the condition of each of the several canals along the two branches of the Susquehanna, the Susquehanna and Juniata rivers, and their connections with the Union, the Schuylkill, and the Susquehanna and Tidewater canals: on costs of advisable repairs and improvements on each; on tonnages of coal transported on each in comparison with tonnages carried by railroads from areas adjacent to each; in brief, an excellent picture of canal operations in Pennsylvania in 1865.
