L. The Schuylkill Navigation Company Papers held by the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission, the Pennsylvania Museum Building, Harrisburg

The Schuylkill Navigation Company Papers were transferred during the months of April and May of 1951 from the custody of the Schuylkill River Project to that of the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum Commission, to be held by that commission as the property of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. Before 1951, the papers had been successively owned by the Schuylkill Navigation Company, the Philadelphia and Reading Railroad, and the Schuylkill Project.

Historically, these papers are of considerable importance, reflecting as they do significant eras of inland waterway transportation and commerce; the enterprise of late eighteenth- and early nineteenth-century Pennsylvania citizens and men of affairs; the inter-relationships of navigation companies and railroad companies; and, in Pennsylvania, the eventual supplanting by the railroads of transportation services long performed in that state by artificial canalways.
