- 118. Presents a contract with John A. Roebling for wire ropes to be used on Planes 2 and 3, 1845.
- 122-127. Present contracts for bituminous coal for use at the stationary engines at the head of the inclined planes, 1836.
- 128. Presents a contract for coke to be used in the locomotive engine on the railroad, 1834.
- 129-161. Present contracts for the laying of a second track, 1834.

Stringers, ties, etc.

- 1- 77. Present contracts, 1843 - 1848, for lumber from various trees and in various forms: cross ties, stringers, shingles, string timber, etc.
- 78-290. Present contracts, 1837 - 1848, for horse power, that is: "horses, drivers, harness, etc., etc., as may be required to convey all cars containing passengers, goods, merchandise, and all other articles and things, etc."
