3. Presents similar Articles for Smith, Boyd & Harker of Cambria County to furnish the other half of such castings - 1844.
9. Records the Article of Agreement by which Thomas Young of Johnstown conveys his boat plane (boat slip) at Johnstown, with all the fixtures, machinery, and rope required and now in use for working the plane, to the Commonwealth - 10 September 1842.
