

- 50-221. Present contracts for the supply of wood for the use of locomotive engines - 1842-1845.
- 222-288. Present contracts for sawing and splitting wood - 1840-1847.
- 289-292. Present contracts with Norris Brothers of Philadelphia - 1848 and 1850 and with D. H. Dotterer & Co. of Reading - 1840, for locomotive engines.
- 293-300. Present contracts for sets of trucks on which the sections of section boats would be drawn out of the canal basin at either Johnstown or Hollidaysburg and transported on the railroad - 1842-45.
- 301. Presents a contract with Emanuel Sheaffer of Johnstown to build and complete one eight-wheel passenger car like the Simon Snyder already in use on the railroad - 1 October 1844.
- 302. This item is a duplicate of item 292, the contract for six locomotive engines with D. H. Dotterer & Co.
