Authority & Appointed & by these presents do
make ordains Authorize and appoint Jacob
Weitzel of the same Borough County &
State Approved our True & lawfull Attorney
for us & in our Name to settle all Accounts
depending between the said Ezekiel Richardson
deceased - And to his use to take for
recover & receive of the United States, or their
the State of Pennsylvania all such Lands
which were allow'd to the Soldiers of the State
of Pennsylvania - and in our Name to make
Sale & deliver & to do all other Lawfull
acts & things whatsoever concerning this as
fully in every respect as if we ourselves might
or could do if we were personally present Witness
our Hands at Lancaster this 4th Day September 1763.
