Demands whatsoever which are or shall be due owing payable
and belonging to me or claimed from me in any manner way
or main whatsoever by the Hon^{ble} the Hon^{ble} of this State
the respective the Quarter Master General's department
and to General and Quarter Master and my true attorney by these
presents my full and whole power strength and authority
in and about the Premises to have see and take all lawful
ways and means in my name for recovering them of and upon the
Receipt of any such Sums of money or Sums of money paid
acquittance or other sufficient discharges for me and in my name
to make seal and deliver and generally all and every other act
or acts devise or devises in the Law whatsoever holden and
necessary to be done in and about the Premises heretofore
of all or any such Sums of money or Sums of money paid
and in my name to do execute and perform as fully largely
and amply to all intents and purposes as if my self might
or could be present or as if the matter were my own
personally there is herein signed and for the purpose aforesaid
to make and constitute and make and perform to be kept
subscribing attesting and publishing in full at all times and
places my attorney of full lawful authority to in and about the Premises
to do and perform all and every thing that may or shall lawfully
be done and to be done in and about the Premises
in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
