This Indenture made and
concluded the Twenty first day of November
Anno Domini 1786 Between Tennon Books
Of the one Part And Francis Murray of
the County of Bucks. in the State of Pennyl.
vanis Esquire of the other Part Witnesses
that the said Tennon Books in Consideration
of the Sum of Thirty seven Pounds Ten Shillings
to him in hand paid by the said Francis
Murray and for other valuable Considerations
doth by these presents grant, bargain and
sell, to lease and confirm unto the said
Francis Murray his Heirs and Assigns for
Ever a Certain Tract of Land in one of
the Donation Districts in the County of
Westmoreland containing Two Hundred
& fifty Acres and Allowance of Six Cent for Roads
In District N^o 4 and Lot N^o 79 and
I do desire that the Patent may issue in the
Name and as the property of said Francis
Murray his Heirs and Assigns for Ever and
I do by these presents warrant and defend
the said Two Hundred Acres of Land & from
me my Heirs and Assigns for Ever all and
every other person and persons whatsoever
lawfully claiming or to claim by from or
under ~~me~~ him them or any of them. In Witness
